OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BODICOTE PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20**

Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Bodicote Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 5. The Oxfordshire County Council (Bodicote Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 is hereby revoked/replaced.

SCHEDULE 1

20mph speed limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Bodicote, west of and excluding the A4260 Oxford Road, extending in the case of the roads leading out of the village to the following points:

a)	Wykham Lane	a point 342 metres west of its junction with White Post Road / High Street.
b)	Broad Gap	its junction with the A420 Oxford Road
c)	Weeping Cross	its junction with the A420 Oxford Road
d)	White Post Road	its junction with Blackwell Drive
