## Background to project – Bankside

POWER ON 

- Power On have been engaged to bring in 1603KVA of electrical capacity to supply 860 new homes at the new David Wilson homes bankside development on Oxford Road Banbury.
- The only capacity available from National Grid is at Ellis Lane Primary Substation 7km away and a further upgrade on Molyneux Drive.
- Therefore, to bring this capacity in, a 7km cable route is required to be constructed

## Our Plan of Works:

We are mindful of the potential disruption this work will cause, so this work is programmed to start so less impact to the local schools with most of the works being carried out during School Holidays.

### WHY ROAD CLOSURES.

- Wykham Lane and Ells Lane : Road width is too narrow to allow 2-way lights to be utilised through the area. This is why a road closures are necessary for the works to be completed.
- **Safety is Paramount** for members of public and our working teams. The Road closures avoid 'pinch points' of traffic and working teams being in proximity.
